

Klemens Schillinger

Klemens Schillinger was born in Vienna in 1983.

He studied at the FH Joanneum in Graz and the Royal College of Art in London.

After his studies he worked for various design studios in London and Vienna, but also on his own projects and products. Among others he worked for international companies Kvadrat and Hem but also for traditional companies like the Viennese jeweller A&E Köchert.

Since 2014 he lives and works in his home city Vienna and is active in the fields of product furniture and exhibition design.

He is a member of the association Spazio Pulpo, a space for experimental design, in the area between design and art.

In 2018 he received the Swarovski Award for Excellence in Austrian Design and the following year the Design Concept Award at the Austrian State Prize for Design.

His work has been shown in exhibitions at the Design Museum Holon in Israel, the Museum of Applied Arts in Vienna and the Victoria & Albert Museum in London.
